A RESOLUTION TO ONCE AGAIN CLASSIFY POLICE BODY-WORN CAMERA AND DASHBOARD CAMERA RECORDINGS AS PUBLIC RECORDS

WHEREAS, The public should have the right to view police dashboard camera and body-worn camera video; and

WHEREAS, Until recently body-worn camera and dashboard camera recordings were considered public record; and

WHEREAS, Transparency is necessary to public confidence in the rule of law; and

WHEREAS, The public has the right to hold law enforcement officers to a high standard of behavior; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Democratic Party supports that police body-worn camera and dashboard camera recordings shall once again be considered public record as it was before the passing of NC House Bill 972.
