## Democratic Women Meet

Dare Spicer, Executive Director of the Randolph County Family Crisis Center, spoke at the February 23rd meeting of the Democratic Women of Randolph County. She outlined the evolution of this vital service to battered women and children from its beginning in 1978 to today, when about 35% of its clients are men. Dare emphasized the outstanding support given by the City of Asheboro and our community to this cause. Today the Family Crisis Center consists of 30 employees, two shelters, and four advocacy centers, including Emmy's House Children's Advocacy Center.

The Family Crisis Center is funded by matching grants and through sales at its upscale shop, The Red Door Resale Clothing Boutique, located at 129 Sunset Avenue in Asheboro, across the street from Democratic Headquarters. Be sure to visit and support this worthy cause.

**During March we will be collecting items for the Family Crisis Center.** Their most urgent needs are paper products such as toilet paper and paper towels, laundry detergent, and cleaning supplies.
