Randolph County Democratic Party Education Scholarship Policy

As part of our commitment to civic engagement, education, and community service, the Randolph County Democratic Party offers one or more annual scholarships in the amount of \$500 each to graduating high school seniors. Awards are made as a one-time payment to the recipient's post-secondary institution.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be graduating seniors attending a public high school governed by an elected school board in Randolph County (currently Asheboro City Schools or Randolph County Schools).
- Be planning to attend a two-year or four-year college, university, or accredited vocational/technical school.
- Be of any political affiliation.

Selection Criteria

Applicants will be evaluated based on:

- 1. **Civic Engagement** including campaign work, election volunteering, or other political involvement.
- 2. **Community Service** non-political volunteerism or service to others.
- 3. **Public Engagement or Work Experience** such as part-time jobs, internships, or leadership roles.
- 4. Essay Quality applicants will respond to a prompt based on the Randolph County Democratic Party's purpose statement.

Essay Evaluation

Essays will be assessed on:

- Demonstrated understanding of the Party's purpose statement.
- Depth and relevance of the student's experiences.
- Clarity of future educational and career plans.
- Evidence of potential for success.
- Overall writing quality (organization, grammar, spelling, and style).

Additional Notes

- Financial need is not a consideration due to limited evaluation resources.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified by spring 2026.
